DAY ONE: PRAY FOR THE HUB: LAS VEGAS

THE HUB LAS VEGAS IS ON A MISSION TO GIVE EVERYONE IN LAS VEGAS ACCESS TO A RESTORED LIFE.

DAY TWO: PRAY FOR FULL RESTORATION OF LIVES

"For he will deliver the needy when he cries for help, the afflicted also, and him who has no helper. He will have compassion on the poor and needy, and the lives of the needy He will save. He will rescue their life from oppression and violence, and their blood will be precious in his sight." Psalm 72:12 - 14

PRAY FOR LIVES TO BE RESTORED THROUGH RESCUE.

- Pray for the vulnerable to be rescued from toxic physical situations, life-controlling circumstances, direct danger, unhealthy environments, abuse, and exploitation.

PRAY FOR LIVES TO BE RESTORED THROUGH RELATIONSHIPS.

- Pray for the vulnerable to experience a transformative relationship with Jesus and a life filled with a safe, healthy community with others.

PRAY FOR LIVES TO BE RESTORED THROUGH RESOURCES.

- Pray for the vulnerable to have their basic needs met – food, shelter, clothing, employment, education, Etc.

PRAY FOR LIVES TO BE RESTORED THROUGH RECOVERY.

- Pray for the vulnerable to be set free from addictions, mental illness, trauma, exploitation, and the many side effects of poverty.

PRAY FOR LIVES TO BE RESTORED THROUGH RECONCILIATION.

- Pray for the vulnerable to be reconciled to God and experience His heart for unity, equity, and justice.

DAY THREE: PRAY FOR PURCHASED: LAS VEGAS

PURCHASED: LAS VEGAS PROVIDES RESCUE, RELATIONSHIPS, RESOURCES, RECOVERY, AND RECONCILIATION FOR THE SEXUALLY EXPLOITED AND SEX TRAFFICKED.

“Open your mouth for the mute, for the rights of all the unfortunate. Open your mouth, judge righteously, and defend the rights of the afflicted and needy.” Proverbs 31:8,9

“Straightening up, Jesus said to her, ‘Woman, where are they? Did no one condemn you?’ She said, ‘No one, Lord.’ And Jesus said, ‘I do not condemn you, either. Go. From now on sin no more.’” John 8:10,11

PRAY FOR TEEN SURVIVORS.

Did you know that the average age of entry into sex trafficking is 14-16 years old? Teen survivors of trafficking are scattered all across the Las Vegas valley. Sex trafficking breaks the heart of God.

Pray these children would be

- freed from their abuse.
- put on a path to recovery.
- have their hope and faith restored through a relationship with Jesus.
- found and plugged into life-restoring resources.

PRAY FOR THE “BUYERS” FUELING THE DEMAND.

Did you know the buying of sex is what creates the demand for human trafficking? If demand decreases, supply will also decrease, resulting in fewer people being trafficked.

Pray the buyers:

- would be convicted of their sins, repent, and seek help and restoration.
- whose hearts who are addicted to pornography and sex would be healed completely.
- would encounter Jesus, and as a result, understand their identity and whom they are called to be in Him.

PRAY FOR THE RECLAIMED PROGRAM.

Did you know that recovering from any trauma and breaking wrong behaviors isn't as easy as changing desires? Girls in the Reclaimed program are placed with families who can give them the grace to get to the next step in their journey of recovery and have a tangible example of love and grace in the family they live with.

Pray for the girls in the Reclaimed Recovery Program and their foster parents:

- for the girls who are working daily on recovering from their past trauma and are working towards a restored future.

- for the foster parents currently in our Reclaimed Homes program.
- that more families would join the Reclaimed Homes program to take in teen survivors of trafficking.
- for endurance, peace, hope, and restoration for all who are involved.
- that the girls and their families would put their faith in Jesus and see Him as their true source of hope, restoration, and joy.

DAY FOUR: PRAY FOR FOSTERING HOPE

FOSTERING HOPE EXISTS TO PROVIDE RESOURCES, RELATIONSHIPS AND RECOVERY TO FOSTER FAMILIES, BIO PARENTS AND CHILDREN IN FOSTER CARE, CREATING AVENUES OF RECONCILIATION AND FULL RESTORATION.

"Pure and undefiled religion in the sight of our God and Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their distress, and to keep oneself unstained by the world." James 1:27

"Learn to do good; seek justice, correct oppression; bring justice to the fatherless, plead the widow's cause." Isaiah 1:17

PRAY FOR KIDS IN CARE.

Pray for children who have suffered and endured much loss and are in constant fear of what will come next: where they will sleep tonight, where their next meal will come from, or where their siblings and biological family are.

- Pray for a sense of belonging that comes from knowing God as their Father and for protection of their hearts and minds.
- Pray for God's grace to cover their loss and miraculously heal their hearts of pain.
- Pray that God would give them thoughts for a better future and a desire to live in that hope.

PRAY FOR BIOLOGICAL PARENTS AND FAMILIES.

Pray for parents who are trying to overcome addiction, have a case plan to work that feels overwhelming, and that are working through their own trauma to be reunited with their children.

- Pray God would bring healthy mentors into their lives and for people who desire to walk alongside them on their journey.
- Pray for our leaders and volunteers in Fostering Hope as they come alongside biological parents to give them access to a restored life and reconciliation back to their children.

PRAY FOR FOSTER FAMILIES (BOTH FOR FOSTER PARENTS AND CHILDREN).

- Pray God would provide loving connections between children in foster care and their foster parents.
- Pray God would give rest to foster parents who are weary and feeling overwhelmed. Specifically pray Matthew 11:28 over foster parents, which says, "Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest."
- Pray God would overwhelm the children in foster care with a supernatural ability to trust Him in all things as they have an understandable and constant fear of trusting anyone in their lives.

PRAY FOR CASEWORKERS AT THE DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY SERVICES.

- Pray for clear communication between workers and families.
- Pray for endurance for workers with high caseloads.
- Pray that each caseworker would have a support system that helps keep them healthy and protects them from burn out.

DAY FIVE: PRAY FOR THE LOVEWELL CENTER

THE LOVEWELL CENTER GIVES RESCUE, RELATIONSHIPS, RESOURCES, AND RECOVERY TO PEOPLE EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY THROUGH AN EMPOWERING MODEL THAT ENCOURAGES EARNING AND PARTICIPATION.

PRAY FOR THOSE WHO ARE HOMELESS IN OUR CITY.

- Pray for their safety and protection.
- Pray that they feel seen, known, and loved.
- Pray that they get connected to The Lovewell Center and, find a place that they belong and their needs are met.

PRAY FOR ACCESS TO RESOURCES.

- Pray for The Lovewell Center to develop connections with mental health services and rehabilitation centers so that the homeless community can receive the quickest and most excellent help available to them.
- Pray that The Lovewell Center would assist their homeless members in finding safe and stable housing.

FOR THE LOVEWELL CENTER VOLUNTEERS.

- Pray for both God's strength and the filling of the Holy Spirit for staff and volunteers as they engage the homeless community.
- Pray for ease of communication between our volunteers and the ones they serve.
- Pray that trust will be built and that relationships can develop that are both healthy and supportive.

DAY SIX: PRAY FOR CULTIVATE

CULTIVATE EMPOWERS THE NEXT GENERATION THROUGH CULTIVATING HEALTHY FAMILIES, SAFE COMMUNITIES, AND THRIVING EDUCATIONAL SYSTEMS.

"And whoever in the name of a disciple gives to one of these little ones even a cup of cold water to drink, truly I say to you, he shall not lose his reward." Matthew 10:42

"Whoever receives one child like this in My name receives Me; and whoever receives Me does not receive Me, but Him who sent Me." Mark 9:37, 42

PRAY FOR STUDENTS:

Many students in Clark County have lost a portion of their support system and are distance learning on their own.

- Pray for endurance, encouragement, and healthy relationships for these students.
- Pray for the peace of heart and mind: depression and anxiety among children are rising due to the circumstances of Covid-19 and distance learning.
- Pray that God would restore any social needs that have been lost in our students.
- Pray that students would use this time to connect with their families.

PRAY FOR PARENTS AND GUARDIANS.

- Pray parents and guardians of students would be able to wisely juggle family life, work life, and now distance-learning.
- Pray for patience with their children and with teachers.
- Pray for understanding that no one is at fault.
- Pray for insight to see their part in helping their students learn.
- Pray God would provide what parents need to take care of their families: income, time, and wisdom.

PRAY FOR HARMON ELEMENTARY.

Harmon Elementary is Cultivate's first school partner.

- Pray for relationships to be built that foster trust and for clear pathways of partnership with the school.
- Pray that Cultivate would greatly impact the families of Harmon Elementary with the gospel.
- Pray for peace in homes and the provision of resources to meet all of the needs of the students at Harmon and for those students' families.

DAY SEVEN: PRAY FOR WHERE GOD MAY USE YOU IN THE CITY
