# TO MAKE THE MOBILE

The help of an **adult** may be needed when cutting and assembling the mobile



Print out all the pages of the mobile onto card. (160 + gsm copy card is suitable)



Colour in the 'Pentecost Flame' main piece and the three smaller flame pieces then cut them all out.



Fold the main piece back along the dotted line then glue the front to the back.



Punch out the holes at the top and bottom where marked



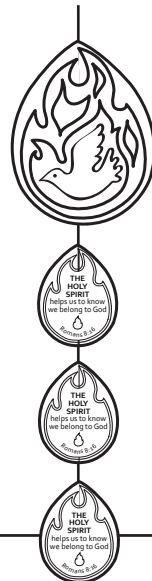
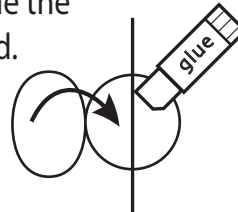
Cut one length of thread approx. 35cm / 14 inches long and tie onto the bottom hole of the main piece



Fold each of three flame pieces in half and glue the front to the back around each length of thread.



Tie a length of thread to the top to hang up.



## OTHER WAYS TO USE THIS ACTIVITY



You can use this artwork to make a Pentecost Flame headband. Print out the 'HEADBAND' page. Colour in. Cut out the larger flame and the six smaller single sided flames then glue onto a strip of card approx. 6cm/ 2.5 inches wide and as long as needed to go around the head.



Fold round and glue to make a headband
